- Who writes the tickets? Answer: Authorized town officials will be writing citations for ordinance violations, parking violations, etc. Numerous towns have hired off-duty officers for monitoring and issuing traffic citations. Those officers are busy and may not be able to commit to serving more towns than are already signed up.
- What to do about people showing up at the Glenmore Community Center when court is not in session? Answer: After discussion the agreement was that a permanent sign be placed at the Glenmore Community Center. It should indicate that the court is not currently in session or whatever wording is necessary to direct them to Court personnel rather than bothering others who are renting the Community Center.
